| Equitable | Does not unfairly burden or benefit one group in society Promotes equity and social justice | |
| Efficient | Uses resources efficiently & effectively Cost-effective | |
| Feasible | Has adequate staff and resources for implementation Enforceable Has a lead responsible agency or organization Has mandated results and outcomes Sustainable (institutionally) Can be replicated | |
| Healthful | Improves the health of residents Prevents disease | |
| Scalable | Can be done on a small scale as a pilot effort | |
| Upstream | Addresses root causes not symptoms Strives for radical systemic change | |
| Inclusive | Responds to the needs of all social, ethnic, cultural groups Has broad and deep stakeholder support Promotes community participation and dialogue Avoids involuntary displacement Promotes autonomy and control | |
| Multi-objective Strategic Comprehensive | Advances multiple objectives simultaneously Facilitates the achievement of other strategies Does not inhibit the achievement of other objectives | |
| Promotes Ecological Sustainability | Has long term beneficial impacts Protect the needs of future generations | |
| Politically Viable | Can achieve sufficient public / political support | |
